



SUBJECT: Issuance of Department of Commerce Controlled Unclassified
Information Policy and Guidelines

I am pleased to introduce the inaugural Department of Commerce (DOC) Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) Policy and Guidelines, effective immediately. The CUI Policy and Guidelines were developed in a collaborative Department-wide effort to provide overall policy and detailed guidance for implementation of Executive Order 13556 and 32 CFR Part 2002, both entitled Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI). This information security reform addresses inconsistent, and often conflicting, patchwork of over 100 different agency-specific policies, markings, and other requirements used to control information requiring protection in accordance and consistent with laws, regulations, and Government-wide policies throughout the Executive Branch.

Bureaus are required to identify their Bureau CUI Point of Contact within 30 days and submit their Bureau-specific Implementation Plan within 90 days of issuance of this memorandum. Submissions are to be submitted to the DOC CUI Program Office mailbox at CUI@doc.gov.
